Invitation for Bids

Procurement of FDI Vaccines and Syringes for the Financial Year 2024-25

The Federal Directorate of Immunization (FDI), Ministry of National Health Services, Regulations & Coordination, Government of Pakistan, invites technical and financial bids in separate sealed Envelopes on Delivered Duty Paid (DDP) basis at the FDI office, Prime Minister's National Health Complex, Chak Shahzad, Park Road, Islamabad from original Manufacturers, their Authorized Agents and Suppliers in Pakistan registered with Income Tax and Sales Tax Departments and on Active Payers List (APL) of FBR for FDI Vaccines and syringes. 2. Interested eligible bidders may obtain bidding documents from the Federal Directorate of Immunization on submission of a written application along with payment of a non-refundable fee of Rs. 2,000/- (Rupees two thousand only). Bidding documents will be issued during office hours up to a day before opening of the bids. However, a copy of the bidding documents will be available for information on the website of the Public Procurement Regulatory Authority (PPRA) i.e. www.ppra.org.pk and <http://eprocure.gov.pk> until the closing date for submission of bids.

3. In accordance with the provision of Rule 36(b) of Public Procurement Rules, 2004 and terms and condition defined in the bidding documents, Single stage – two envelopes bidding procedure specified in the Public Procurement Rules, 2004 shall be followed for receiving and processing the bids. All proposals must be accompanied by a Bid Security in the shape of a pay order/bank draft/call deposit receipt/bank guarantee is required to be deposited in the name of the **Drawing & Disbursing Officer of FDI, Islamabad**. Any financial proposal not accompanied by the pay order/bank draft/call deposit receipt/bank guarantee shall be rejected.

4. All the interested bidders are required to register themselves and submit their bid online technical and financial proposals through E-PADS at <http://eprocure.gov.pk>.

5. Moreover, the original proposals, **Separate sealed bids for each of the above-mentioned FDI Vaccines and syringes should be dropped in the tender box provided for the purpose** in the Federal Directorate of Immunization, Prime Minister's National Health Complex, Chak Shahzad, Park Road, Islamabad **up to 11.00 hours on 5th December 2024 (Thursday)**. Bids will be opened publically on the same day at 12.00 Hours in the Conference Room of FDI by the Federal Procurement Committee in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives.

6. Bidders are requested to give their best and final prices as negotiations on the price once quoted/offered are not permissible under the Rules. The competent authority reserves the right to reject all bids at any time prior to acceptance of a bid or proposal and also increase or decrease the quantities as per Rule 33 of PPRA Rules 2004.
